## **2015 – 2016 Undergraduate Scholarships** *For New-Nontraditional, Current, Returning and Transfer Students*

### **Application Deadline: March 2, 2015**

Scholarship recipients must register fall, 2015 and spring, 2016 for the *required minimum registration* in class sections offered at the Lake Campus. Funds will not be disbursed unless the recipient registers in the minimum credit hours each semester. Registration must be completed by the first day of each semester. The total award amount(s) will be divided equally and applied toward the recipient's WSU Bursar fall and spring semester student accounts. If a student drops below the *required minimum number of credit hours*, the award disbursement may be canceled.

Should a recipient be unable to attend either the fall or spring semester of the academic year, he/she may petition in writing to request to use the disbursement during the summer semester of the award year. If a recipient is graduating mid-year of the academic year, he/she may petition in writing to request that the total award be applied to his/her fall semester. All letters of petition should be sent to the Scholarship Coordinator, WOEFC-LC Scholarships, 104 Dwyer Hall, 7600 Lake Campus Drive, Celina, Ohio 45822 and received prior to the 15th day of August of the award year.

Recipients must maintain the academic standards of their intended major and/or scholarship sponsor. If a recipient does not maintain the required academic standards, he/she can be placed on scholastic probation and future scholarship disbursements withheld.

A recipient placed on probation must show continuous academic improvement to receive future distributions. To be removed from scholastic probation, the recipient must attain the required grade point average (GPA). Recipients who receive a scholarship that is renewable for one or more years must achieve a 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA by the end of the spring semester of the first year of disbursement, and each subsequent year of renewal. Recipients placed on probation will be ineligible to receive any other WOEFC scholarship for one (1) year after the scholastic probation period ends.

- The combined totals of Western Ohio Educational Foundation (WOEFC) scholarship assistance may not exceed the total cost of tuition.
- All Wright State University grade point averages (GPA) are based on a 4.0 grading system.
- Scholarships are awarded on an "as funds are available" basis.
- The *Application Deadline* is March 2, 2015.
- *Required Documents* include an application form, list of activities and/or employment, essay(s), and transcript(s).
- *Required Documents* sent by USPS must be postmarked by the *Application Deadline* to be considered.
- Applicants for the scholarships listed in this packet must be a *new-nontraditional, current, returning or transfer* student who is eligible to enroll fall semester, 2015 at Wright State University as a degree-seeking student.
- The University and the Foundation reserve the right to cancel a scholarship award if a recipient is found guilty of academic dishonesty.

  - Under "Reference Provider Data", list the names and telephone numbers of the two (2) individuals who have agreed to provide a confidential reference on your behalf
- Attach a separate sheet listing all extracurricular activities and/or employment for the past two (2) years
- Write a one-page essay (required) and any optional essays that pertain to the applicant (essay topics, page 4)
- A copy of your academic advising report can be acquired through the WSU *Wings Express* portal. Log in to *Wings Express*, print your individual advising report, and attach it with your application documents.

**If any Required Document is not received by the Application Deadline, the application will be deemed ineligible for consideration**

The following scholarship opportunities are intended for Lake Campus new/nontraditional, current, returning, or transfer undergraduate students. Recipients must register at least six (6) or more credit hours each semester unless otherwise noted below. Applicants who meet the individual award criteria, have the highest overall judges' rating within the award category and have not been awarded a higher or equal valued WOEf scholarship.

### **Van Tilburg Farms Scholarship - \$3,000 1<sup>st</sup> Year, Renewable Up to Two Years**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student who has earned at least 30 or more credit hours and who is pursuing either a Bachelor of Technical Study, Agriculture concentration or a Bachelor of Organizational Leadership, Agriculture concentration. Recipient selected based upon his/her academic records, and work, school or community activities. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **Stephen & Opal Jagoditz Scholarship –\$3,000**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student who resides in Auglaize County. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs, work or volunteer experience and academic records. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **Richard & Catharine Sharp Estate Scholarship –\$3,000**

One (1) award. Awarded to a Mercer County student. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs, work or volunteer experience and academic records. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **Reuben & Leola Wissman Scholarship –Up to \$3,000, Various Awards**

Various awards. Awarded to students enrolled in an engineering program or engineering related activity. Recipients selected according to his/her situational needs, work or volunteer experience and academic records. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **Victor Fuhrwerk Memorial Scholarship - \$3,000**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student who resides in Auglaize, Darke, Mercer or Van Wert County and who has earned a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **Mercer County Civic Foundation Health Care Scholarship - \$1,500**

Up to three (3) awards. Awarded to a Mercer or Auglaize County student who enrolls in a medical or health care degree program at the Lake Campus.

### **Rockford Fraternal Order of Eagles, Shanes Aerie 1292 - \$1,500**

Two (2) awards. If no eligible 2015 Parkway graduate applies; then, continuing education students who reside in the Parkway school district and who are or have a family member who is a member of the Rockford Eagles will be considered. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **The Reynolds & Reynolds Foundation Scholarship - \$1,250**

Four (4) awards. Awarded to students who reside in Mercer or Auglaize County and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Recipients must demonstrate the intent to stay in or return to the Celina area upon graduation. Recipients selected according to their situational needs, volunteer work, and academic records. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **Dorothy A. & Lester J. Brandewie & Family Scholarship - \$1,200**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student who resides in Allen, Auglaize, Darke, Mercer, Shelby or Van Wert County and has a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. Recipient must major in music or demonstrate an interest in music. Minimum registration is twelve (12) or more credit hours.

### **Bernard & Marilyn Schroer & Family Scholarship- \$1,000**

One (1) award. Awarded to an Auglaize County resident who has achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at his/her current school.

### **St. Marys Fraternal Order of Eagles, Aerie 767 Continuing Education Scholarships – \$750**

Five (5) awards. Awarded to St. Marys area residents and Auglaize County residents.

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## **Trustees General Scholarship - \$750**

Two (2) awards. Awarded to students who are in good standing at his/her current school. Recipients selected according to his/her situational needs and academic records.

## **Donald Krischak Memorial Scholarship – \$750**

One (1) award. Awarded to students who are in good standing at his/her current school. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs, work or volunteer experience and school or community activities.

## **Raymond & Patricia Giesige Memorial Scholarship – \$750**

One (1) award. Awarded to Mercer County students who are in good standing at his/her current school. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs, work or volunteer experience and school or community activities.

## **Jenny Seas Book Scholarship - \$600**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student who is majoring in a business degree program. Recipient selected based upon his/her academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience, and school or community activities.

## **Richard Raudabaugh Memorial Scholarship - \$600**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student who enrolls in the Bachelor of Technical Studies - Agriculture Option degree program. Recipient must have a 2.5 or higher GPA.

## **Tom & Ann Knapke & Family Scholarship - \$600**

One (1) award. Awarded to any student with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. Recipient must enroll for at least seven (7) or more credit hours each semester and must participate in and complete at least one campus-sponsored recreational activity during the academic year.

## **Roger & Vicki Fulk & Family Scholarship - \$500**

One (1) award. Awarded to a Lake Campus undergraduate student who has earned at least 30 or more credit hours while maintaining a 2.5 or higher GPA. Recipient must major in business and demonstrate a special need or circumstance.

## **Mercer County Sheriff's Reserve Association Law Enforcement Scholarship - \$500**

One (1) award. Awarded to a Mercer County resident who will pursue either the Associate of Science degree in Law Enforcement, or the Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice. The WOEf Board will match this award for an additional \$500 for a total scholarship of \$1,000 if the recipient attends Wright State University - Lake Campus.

## **St. Marys Fraternal Order of Eagles, Aerie 767 Law Enforcement Scholarship - \$500**

One (1) award. Awarded to an Auglaize County student who is enrolled in the Associate of Science degree in Law Enforcement, or the Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice.

## **Rockford Fraternal Order of Eagles, Aerie 1292 Law Enforcement Scholarship - \$500**

One (1) award. Awarded to a Parkway school district student or to any student who is or has a parent or relative who is a member of the Rockford Eagles and who will enroll in the Associate of Science degree in Law Enforcement, or the Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice.

## **Bachelor of Applied Science, Technical Studies Degree Program Scholarship - \$500**

Two (2) awards available. Awarded to students who are pursuing a Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Technical Studies. Recipients selected based upon his/her academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience and school or community activities.

## **Office Information Systems Program Scholarship - \$500**

Two (2) awards available. Awarded to students who are pursuing an Associate of Applied Business degree in the Office Information Systems (OIS) program. Recipients selected based upon his/her academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience, and school or community activities.

## **Barbara Hicks Memorial Book Scholarship - \$250**

One (1) award. Awarded to a current, returning or transfer student who resides in Mercer County and has earned a 2.5 or higher GPA. Recipients selected based upon his/her academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience, and school or community activities.

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## **West Ohio Association of Occupational Health Nurses Book Scholarship - \$250**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student who is pursuing a nursing degree. Recipient selected according to his/her academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience, and school or community activities.

## **Johnathon K. Geiger Memorial Scholarship - \$200**

One (1) award. Awarded to an applicant who is majoring in Organizational Leadership and are in good standing at their current school. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs and academic records.

## **Merritt Wood Memorial Scholarship – \$150**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student in good standing at their current school. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs and academic records.

## **Stateline Writer’s Club Book Scholarship – \$100**

One (1) award. Awarded to a student seeking a Bachelor of Arts degree in English, Journalism or Integrated Language Arts; or a student seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in Education with a Language Arts concentration. Recipient selected based upon his/her academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience, and school or community activities.

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## **Loan Opportunities**

Preference is given to students who are pursuing a two-year technical program. Technical programs include: Office Information Systems, Technical Studies, Management Information Systems, and Financial Management Technology. Borrowers must register for at least six (6) credit hours each semester. Repayment begins nine (9) months after graduation, or after the recipient no longer attends the Lake Campus at least half-time. Recipients are allowed up to three (3) years to repay.

**Roland & Agnes Clausing Loan Funds** are available to graduates of St. Marys Memorial High School with cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 or higher. Loans made up to \$2,000. The loan application form is available by contacting the WOEFLC Scholarship Office, 104 Dwyer Hall, Lake Campus.

**Shelby County Loan Funds** are available to Shelby County entering, current, returning, or transfer students who have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 or higher. Loans made up to \$500. The loan application form is available by contacting the WOEFLC Scholarship Office, 104 Dwyer Hall, Lake Campus.

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## **Non-Profit Scholarships & Matching WOEFLC Scholarships**

The following scholarship opportunities are awarded by the sponsor and can be “matched” by the Western Ohio Educational Foundation (WOEFLC) should the recipient enroll at least six (6) or more credit hours at the Lake Campus of Wright State University.
