Understanding Kenya's Poverty

MARGINS

Use 1-inch margins on each side of page.

In the midst of the booming capitol of Nairobi lies the biggest, hidden cover-up of the world: Kibera Slum. Kibera. Slum is home to roughly one to three million peoples of all nationalities and tribes.

There are approximately 2.5 million slum dwellers in about 200 "settlements" in the Nairobi area, representing 60% of the Nairobi population, but occupying only 6% of the land. Kibera is a field and valley (not quite as large as Central Park) jammed with tin huts, 8 people per hut, with urine and feces running in ruts of the rambling walking paths. (16)

Kibera, being densely populated, houses the trifecta of diseases, murders, rapes, and deaths among men, women and children in East Africa (Lange 13).

IN-TEXT CITATIONS

In-text citations should be used after quoting, paraphrasing, or summarizing. In parentheses, write the authors last name and then page number. If the author is named in the text, only cite the page number. If the author is unknown, use the first few words from the title.

PAGE HEADER

A page header includes your last name and the page number. Headers are made at the top right corner of every page, including the Works Cited page.

TITLE

The title should be 12-point font and centered. Do not underline, bold, or add any other edits.

BLOCK QUOTATIONS

Quotations that are four or more lines in length need to be set apart in a block. They should be double-spaced and indented 1" from the set margin. The end mark should be placed before the citation.

Specific source information (see above). Database Name (if known). Name of Service. Publication Type. Date of Access.

ARTICLE IN A MAGAZINE

Last Name, First Name. "Article Title." Magazine Title Day Month Year: pages. Publication Type.

PERSONAL INTERVIEW OR COMMUNICATION

Last Name, First Name (person being interviewed). Interview type (Personal, Telephone, E-mail). Day Month Year.
