## HOW TO USE A TEXTBOOK



Using your textbook the correct way will help add to a better outcome in your coursework. Get your textbooks as early as possible before your class begins.

## FIRST

- A. Read the front and back of the textbook.
- B. Locate the Table of Contents (see how it connects to your syllabi)
- C. Locate the Appendix and the Glossary.

## SECOND

- A. Skim through the chapter you are about to read
  - a. Read over subtitles
  - b. Look over any pictures, charts, or captions
  - c. Write down any bolded word on a separate sheet of paper

## THIRD

- A. After every section write down one or two summary sentences.
- **B.** Look up any bolded word in the Glossary or a dictionary.
