

\$700 Wright State University-Lake Campus Spirit of Service Scholarship*



Eligibility

Spirit of Service Scholarship applicants must complete volunteer service work to be eligible for this scholarship. The scholarship is open to current Lake Campus degree-seeking students (non-degree and College Credit Plus students are ineligible to apply). The scholarship funds (there are two available) will be applied to the selected recipient's Fall 2017 tuition. Applicants must participate in volunteer service hours during the Spring and/or Summer 2017 semesters in one of three following ways:

- You have completed volunteer service activities coordinated by the Connect2Complete Program through Coordinator, Heather Dorsten
- You have completed service hours through a service-oriented course taken at the Lake Campus
- You coordinated and completed service hours on your own or through a WSU-Lake Campus student organization

Application Process and Deadlines

The application process for the Spirit of Service Scholarship is through a selection process comprised of a committee of WSU-Lake Campus employees. To be considered for the Spirit of Service Scholarship, **you must complete your application and email it by the deadline on Monday July 31, 2017 by 4:00 pm.** Completed applications include the following:

- Attached Spirit of Service Scholarship Application (PDF is fillable and must be emailed. No paper applications accepted)
- Essay (approximately 500 words) or Video project (approximately 3 minutes) detailing interest in and commitment to service activities and what you learned from the service (Essays must be in Word or PDF format; Video projects must be in MP4 format)
- Must be emailed by the deadline stated above. In the email subject line you must write: SOS 2017 Scholarship Application [Last Name, First Name]. Email to lucy.flowers@wright.edu

What will be Considered?

The Spirit of Service Scholarship committee will closely examine and consider the following:

- Completion of Spirit of Service application by the stated deadline
- List of service activities (on application) including an approximate number of hours and a brief description of each activity
- Completion of Essay or Video project
- Demonstration of learning through service
